## Welcome to the HLMGA Seed Library!

We invite you to select up to 5 packets at a time to plant in your own garden, whether it is in the ground or in a container. Once the plants have grown, and then gone to seed, we ask that you collect the seeds and donate some back to the seed library.

That's how it works!



## How to check out seeds:

- Read the reference book for information about the seeds they are categorized (mostly) by level of difficulty in growing: Easy (Green sticker), Moderate (Blue sticker), and Difficult (Yellow sticker).
- Select up to 5 packets at a time.
- Fill out the check out form with the name of each plant/varietal and the number of each and place the check out form in the Admin-Bin. This is how we adjust the inventory.
- Please be aware there are some toxic varietals that should not be planted where young children and pets could be affected. They have a RED sticker.

## How to donate seeds:

- Collect 10-20 seeds of the same varietal into an envelope. Seeds must be dry. See instructions on the HLMGA website on how to gather seeds, if needed.
- Label the envelope with your name, the date, the plant and varietal, and any instructions for the next gardener.
- Bring the donation packets to the HLMGA Seed Library, and fill out a donation form if possible with your contact information.
