

Welcome to the HLMGA Seed Library!

We invite you to select up to 5 packets at a time to plant in your own garden, whether it is in the ground or in a container. Once the plants have grown, and then gone to seed, we ask that you collect the seeds and donate some back to the seed library. That's how it works!



How to check out seeds:

- Read the reference book for information about the seeds - they are categorized (mostly) by level of difficulty in growing: Easy (Green sticker), Moderate (Blue sticker), and Difficult (Yellow sticker).
 - Select up to 5 packets at a time.
 - Fill out the check out form with the name of each plant/variatal and the number of each and place the check out form in the Admin-Bin. This is how we adjust the inventory.
- *Please be aware there are some toxic variatals that should not be planted where young children and pets could be affected. They have a RED sticker.*

How to donate seeds:

- Collect 10-20 seeds of the same variatal into an envelope. Seeds must be dry. See instructions on the HLMGA website on how to gather seeds, if needed.
- Label the envelope with your name, the date, the plant and variatal, and any instructions for the next gardener.
- Bring the donation packets to the HLMGA Seed Library, and fill out a donation form if possible with your contact information.
